VOLUNTEER REGISTRATION FORM

The Friends of Murphys Point Park (the Friends) is a registered non-profit charity that was formed in 1995. The organization works to enhance the natural heritage education program at Murphys Point Provincial Park. Our mandate is to further the public's awareness, education and understanding of the geological, historical/archaeological, cultural and biological resources of Murphys Point Provincial Park.

Volunteers must be at least 14 years of age as of May 1 of the year of application as a volunteer. Those under age 18 require the signature of a parent or guardian. Orientation and training will be provided to all volunteers prior to the assignment of any tasks to answer questions and ensure the assigned tasks are a good fit. In the case of volunteers returning to a previously completed task, updates will be provided as necessary. A satisfactory Criminal Records Check or Police Records Check for the Vulnerable Sector is required for each volunteer and must be current within a two year window. VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT/RELEASE AND WAIVER FORM
ATTENTION: PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY

I, _____ in participating as a volunteer for the Friends fully understand and agree to the following:

1. I will not be considered to be an employee or independent contractor
2. No fee, payment, salary, wage or employee benefits whatever will be paid to me and I will not be covered by Workplace Safety Insurance Board coverage.
3. The Friends' insurance policy provides coverage for our volunteers while performing duties related to the conduct of Friends' business but only within the scope of their assigned volunteer tasks. This coverage protects them if they were to be sued for an action, or failure to act, that caused injury to someone else or damage to property. It does not provide coverage for the volunteer themselves, if they were injured.
4. I acknowledge that performing volunteer activities may involve certain elements of risk or the chance of an accident and I hereby release the Friends from all claims for loss, damage or injury, except that which is caused solely by the negligence of the Friends, its employees or its agents.
5. I will abide by all applicable Friends policies as may be amended from time to time and will follow all instructions of the appropriate Friends management and/or staff persons in carrying out the volunteer activities.
6. I will not use facilities, equipment and property owned by the Friends without the approval of Friends management.
7. I will not use facilities, equipment and property owned by the Friends for personal purposes.
8. I will immediately notify the appropriate Friends supervisor or management staff of any incident that involves property damage or personal injury to me or any other person during my volunteer activities at any time.
9. The Friends or I may terminate my volunteer activities at any time.
